NDIS Update...

There is so much news in the papers, online, in blogs and elsewhere that it is hard to keep up. The latest is that the Government intends to drop the proposed increase in the Medicare levy to fund the NDIS because the budget can sustain costs. We hope that this is realistic.

Our experience is that NDIS clients have diverse needs – some appear over-funded – in that their budgets are in excess of the care required while others seem under-funded to provide the daily support activities required in their Core Supports.
